Last week year 2 went on a trip to the Grace Darling Museum. We all had an amazing time exploring the museum and learning more facts about Grace Darling.

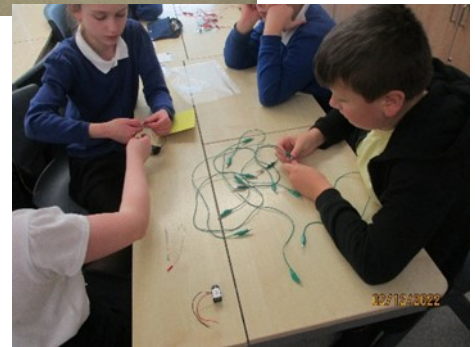
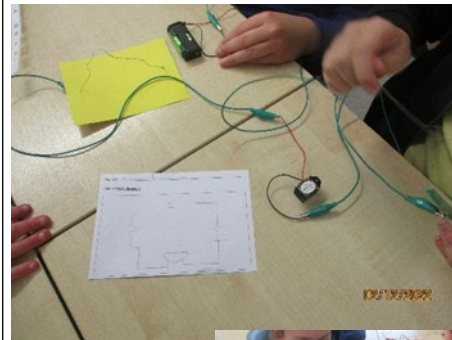
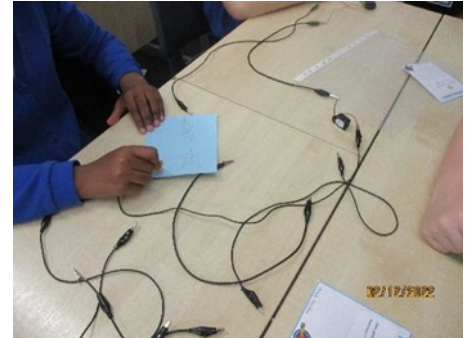
The children enjoyed dressing up and acting out the rescue story. We even got to go to see Grace Darling's grave!
