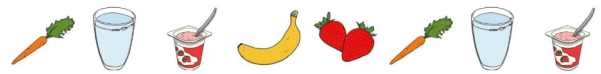
### Heroes of the Week

Every week, a 'Hero of the Week' is chosen from each class and they get to add 10 tokens to their house collection!

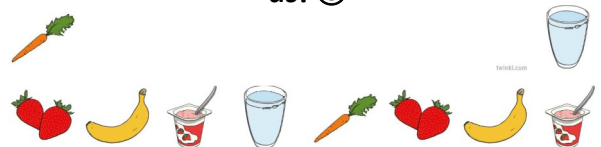


### Tuck Shop

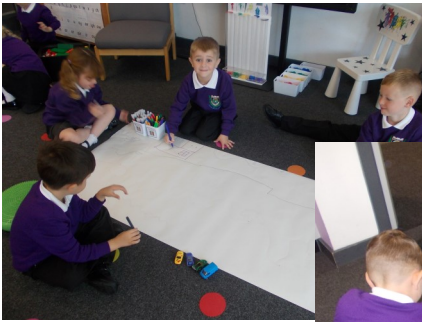
