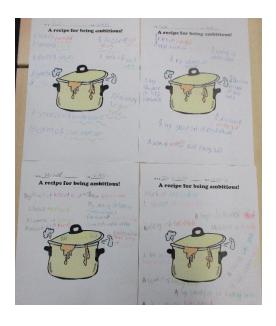






Year 6 thought about the qualities and characteristics of our Hylton Hero – Ambitious Warrior.
