Wellbeing Day

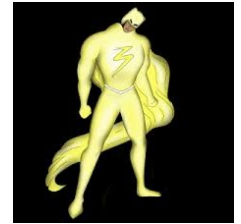
On Tuesday 21st May we will be holding our next wellbeing day. The theme is Colonel Considerate and The Five Ways to Wellbeing theme, to give.

Give

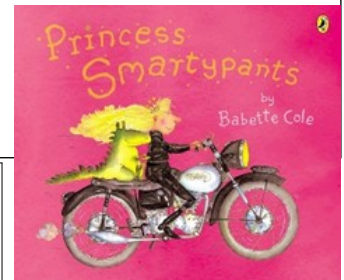
- smile and say thank you

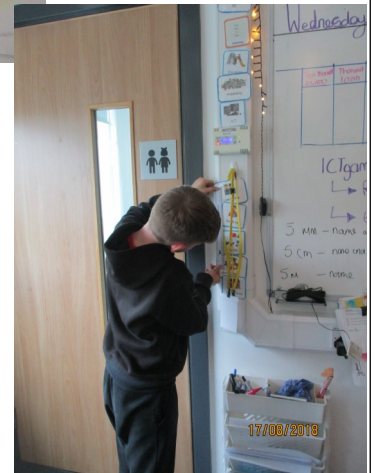
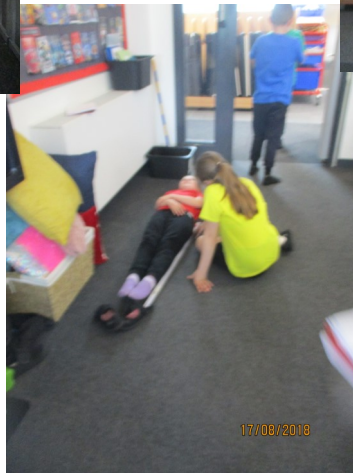
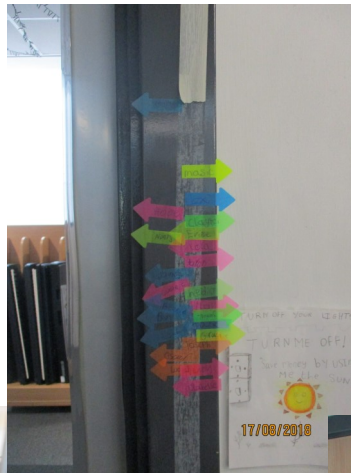
