From September, there will be changes to fixed penalty notices for irregular attendance. Please see the additional information circulated with this newsletter.

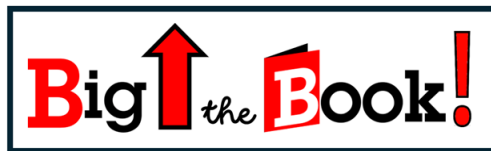
Changes to School Hours from September 2024
